- I. **Baptism Signifies That We Are Now Identified With The Man Of Life, Not The Man Of Death.** 5:12-21

- II. **Baptism Means We Can No Longer Continue Delighting In Sin, Because We Are Now Dead To Sin.** 6:1-2

- III. **Baptism Most Clearly Identifies Us With Christ In His Death.** 6:3-4

- IV. **Baptism Further Identifies Us With Christ In His Resurrected Life.** 6:4-5

- V. **Baptism Affirms That We Are No Longer Enslaved To Sin For That Man Is Now Dead.** 6:6-7

- VI. **Baptism Reflects An Eschatological Confidence That The Life I Have In Christ Is A Life That Will Never End.** 6:8-10

- VII. **Baptism Is The Basis For My Daily Mortification Of The Flesh.** 6:11-14
