

ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS IN LEADING A SOUL TO CHRIST
Acts 8:26-40

When someone comes to Christ, there will be:

- I. A soul winner (messenger). [vs. 26]
 - 1) He was *a spiritual servant*. (cf. Acts 6:1-7, 21:8-9)
 - 2) He was *Spirit sensitive*. [vs. 26, 29, 39]

- II. A sinner (man). [vs.27-28, 30-31]
 - 1) He had *position*. [vs. 27]
 - 2) He had *power*. [vs. 27]
 - 3) He had *prestige*. [vs. 27]
 - 4) He has *a problem*. [vs. 27-28, 30-31]

- III. The Spirit (motivation). [vs. 29-31]
 - 1) We must be *able to hear His instruction*. [vs. 29]
 - 2) We must be *willing to obey His direction*. [vs. 30-31]

- IV. The Scriptures (message). [vs.32-34]
 - 1) Scripture *promised a deliverer*.
 - 2) Scripture *predicted a death*.

- V. A Savior (master). [vs.32-35]
 - 1) He was a *sacrifice*. (cf. Isaiah 53)
 - 2) He was a *substitute*.
 - 3) He was a *satisfaction*.

- VI. Submission (miracle). [vs. 36-38]
 - 1) There was *confession* of Jesus. [vs. 36-37]
 - 2) There was *baptism* in Jesus. [vs. 38]

- VII. Satisfaction (ministry). [vs. 39-40]
 - 1) There was *rejoicing* by the saved. [vs. 39]
 - 2) There was *preaching* by the servant. [vs. 40]
