2. Guard your marriage/family. Psalm 127; Song of Solomon 2:15
3. Protect your thought life. Proverbs 23:7; Romans 12:2; Philippians 2:5
4. Watch your finances. Romans 13:8
5. Remember you are here to learn, not to teach.

 - a. Few things are more valuable than a teachable spirit.
 - b. Study now what you will not study later.
 - c. Commit now to continue to study what you are studying now.

6. Learn to work with, and get along with people (develop your “people skills”).
