(Revelation 1:9-20)

We need to see Jesus when:

I. We endure persecution for God. (v.9)

1. There is partnership in suffering for Jesus.
2. There is pain in suffering for Jesus.
3. There is praise in suffering for Jesus.
4. There is purpose in suffering for Jesus.

II. We receive a commission from God. (v.10-11)

1. Enjoy the Spirit's control. (v.10)
2. Obey the Savior's command. (v.10-11)

III. We have a vision of God. (v.12-16)

1. Jesus is present among His saints. (v.12-13)
2. Jesus is portrayed in all His splendor. (v.13-16)
 - a. In His dress - He is our priest. (v.13)
 - b. In His wisdom - He is profound. (v.14)
 - c. In His insights - He is penetrating. (v.14)
 - d. In His strength - He is permanent. (v.15)
 - e. In His announcements - He is powerful (v.15)
 - f. For His servants - He is protective. (v.16)
 - g. In His judgments - He is perfect. (v.16)
 - h. In His appearance - He is praiseworthy. (v.16)

IV. When we perceive a revelation about God. (v.17-20)

1. He is a comforting God. (v.17)
2. He is a conquering God. (v.18)
3. He is a communicating God. (v.19-20)
