# "The gods of This Age and the Issue of Truth"

2 John 1-13

- There is a battle today for our souls.
  - 1) A battle for our hearts, what we will love.
  - 2) A battle for our minds, what we will believe.
- Only 4% of Americans have a basic biblical worldview. Only 9% of those who say they have been "born again" have a biblical worldview. (It is 2% for teenagers) -George Barna, *Think Like Jesus*, p. 23

#### What are the Basics of a Christian Worldview?

- 1. God is the <u>all-knowing</u>, <u>all-powerful</u> <u>Creator</u> of the universe who still rules that universe today.
- 2. When Jesus Christ was on earth He lived a <u>sinless</u> life.
- 3. Satan is not just a symbol of evil but is a real, living entity.
- 4. A person cannot <u>earn</u> his or her eternal salvation by being good or doing good things for other people; that salvation is the <u>free gift</u> of God.
- 5. Every person who believes in Jesus Christ has a
- 6. <u>personal responsibility</u> to <u>share</u> his or her faith in Him with other people who believe differently.
- 6. The Bible is totally accurate in all that it teaches.

### I. We must love the truth. (2 John 1-3)

- 1) Embrace the truth v. 1-2
  - All truth is God's truth wherever it is found.
  - Truth is <u>essential</u> not optional <u>eternal</u> not relative <u>consistent</u> not changing permanent not perspectival
- 2) Enjoy the truth v. 3
  - Truth brings grace, mercy, and peace.
  - Truth comes from God who is our Father.
  - Truth comes from the Lord Jesus Christ (Messiah).

#### II. We must live the truth. (4-6)

- 1) It matters what you believe v. 4
  - What is your source of authority for determining truth?

Reason – I think

Experience - I feel

<u>Peer pressure</u> – Everyone is doing it

<u>Tradition</u> – We've always done it like this

Revelation - God says

- 2) It matters how you behave v. 5-6
  - Truth is not just something you <u>believe</u>, Truth is also something you <u>live</u>!
  - "What you live is what you really believe, everything else is just talk."
    - Vance Havner

<sup>\*</sup> II Thessalonians 2:10 says that the lost, "perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved."

#### III. We must look for the truth. (7-11)

- ❖ The inescapable question is the <u>Jesus</u> question. What do you think about Him? If you have the wrong answer here, you will have the wrong answer in many other places as well.
- 1) Recognize the deceptive v. 7
  - Their <u>theology</u> is wrong. They think the material world is unimportant.
  - Their <u>Christology</u> is wrong. They think the incarnation did not happen.
- 2) Resist the destructive v. 8
- 3) Reprove the destitute v.9
  - "Do the Math" of False Teaching!
  - (+) They <u>add</u> to the Bible by prophet, professor, or pen.
  - (-) They <u>subtract</u> from the person and work of Jesus Christ. (They deny His <u>eternal deity</u> and find

false or inadequate His atonement for salvation.)

- (x) They <u>multiply</u> the requirements for salvation if indeed they believe in salvation.
- $(\div)$  They <u>divide</u> our allegiance from God in Christ to others.
- 4) Reject the dangerous v. 10-11

# How Do I Witness to Someone Trapped In False Teaching Who Does Not Know Christ As Savior?

- 1) Principles to Remember
  - a) Always be kind.
  - b) Be a good listener.
  - c) Pray for them.
  - d) Love them.

#### 2) Procedure to Follow

- a) Give them 15 minutes uninterrupted asking them to tell you what they believe happens when you die and what you must do to be saved and go to Heaven.
- b) Ask that they give you 15 minutes uninterrupted so that you can tell them how you believe a person can be saved and go to heaven when they die.
- c) Pray with them.
- d) Invite them (and their friends) back to talk again.

## IV. We must long for the truth. (12-13)

- 1) Experience the fullness of joy the truth brings v.12
- 2) Experience the fellowship of a family the truth brings v. 13
  - Truth does exist.
  - Truth does matter.
  - Truth is something we must love.
  - Truth is something we must live.
- Jesus said, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:32)
